

79230 Cere-Stucco Soap

Wax soap made from bleached beeswax and ammonium tartrate. This soap does not contain oil. This wax soap is a water-dilutable colorless white paste. After drying it is insoluble in water.

During the production of the soap, the ammonia is boiled out. The obtained soap smells like soap when it is hot.

In the cold state the soap is almost odorless, after polishing out on the wall the surface becomes odorless after a few days.

The wax on the wall has an exceptionally high aging stability.

Evaporation from the polished wall is no longer possible after drying, any remaining slight alkalinity protects pictures hanging on the wall for harmful acids.

Use:

As a polishing aid for plasters, tadelak, stucco Lustro, for wood wall coverings, as a binder for glazes on the wall. Such wax soaps are also called Punic wax.

Very low consumption.

Cere Stucco soap as a painting agent for oil paint:

Cere Stucco soap is suitable for mixing with oil paint. You can work Cere Stucco soap into oil paint, or mix oil paint on the palette or in the can with Cere Stucco soap. This oil paint Cere Stucco soap mixture can be diluted with water.

Cere Stucco soap as a brush cleaner for oil paints:

Work through the brush with Cere Stucco soap, then rinse with clean water.
